Water Conservation

- Check every faucet in your home for leaks. A slow drip from a leaking faucet can waste 15 to 20 gallons of water per day.
- Don't shower too long or fill the tub to full. Consider 5 minutes of shower and 5 inches of water in the tub.
- Make sure your toilet flapper doesn't stick in the open position after flushing.
- Run your washing machine and dishwasher only when they are full.
- Adjust your sprinklers so only your lawn is being watered and not your house, sidewalk, etc.
- Monitor your water bill for unusually high water usage. Your bill and water meter are tools that can help discover leaks.
